Large & Associates has been instructed by the Solent Coalition Against Nuclear Ships (SCANS) to present its interests at a forthcoming public meeting to be convened by Southampton City Council (SCC) on 4 November 2009. Previously, SCC has referred to a standing arrangement whereby Southampton University will undertake monitoring and report upon the radiation environment in the post incident situation, This monitoring forms a key part of the SCC SOTONSAFE Off-Site Emergency Plan as required under the *Radiation (Emergency Preparedness and Public Information) Regulations 2001* (REPPiR).

Do either of you have knowledge of any existing and continuing arrangement between SCC and the University and, if you do, would you please provide a copy of the contract between the parties, the monitoring and reporting protocols or similar?
